## Application

Before applying, read "Protect" and "Precautionary Measures" sections in the Manufacturer's Product Data Sheet for Fireplace Cleaner. Do not dilute or alter.

- 1. Lightly prewet surface with clean water.
- 2. Spray or brush apply cleaning solution.
- 3. Let cleaner stand for 2-3 minutes. Don't let cleaner dry on the surface.
- 4. Reapply cleaner to heavily soiled areas. Using a soft-fibered scrubbing brush, gently agitate areas of severe soiling.
- 5. Rinse treated surfaces with clean water. If using a sponge, change rinse water frequently.
